REGISTRATION: A \$40.00 non-refundable fee per student is due upon enrollment.

TUITION: TUITION IS DUE IN ADVANCE BY THE FIRST LESSON OF EACH MONTH. YOU WILL RECEIVE A \$10.00 DISCOUNT FOR PAYING BEFORE THE 10TH OF THE MONTH. A FEE OF \$25.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR RETURNED CHECKS.

Tuition is conveniently divided into 9 monthly or 2 semester payments. Tuition is the same for all 9 months. Fees are not pro-rated for shorter months however you will not be charged extra for months with 5 lessons. Please mail checks, drop in mail slot, bring to studio at lesson time, or set up automatic bill-pay with your bank. Statements will be sent for past due accounts only. FULL TUITION IS DUE REGARDLESS OF MISSED LESSONS. In case of prolonged illness, the teacher will schedule a makeup lesson if necessary.

DANCE APPAREL:

Combination Tap/ Ballet classes – black leotards with pink tights, black tap shoes, and pink ballet shoes. Colored leotards may be worn except on Visiting Day.

Tap – black leotards and pink, black or suntan tights. Students may wear a skirt or jazz pants with teacher's permission.

Ballet – black leotards with pink tights. Students may wear a skirt with teacher's permission.

Jazz, Hip Hop, and Musical Theatre – black leotard with black jazz pants for visiting days. Colored leotards & pants are acceptable on non visiting days. Students may wear a fitted dance shirt that extends to the hips. BAGGY, LOOSE-FITTING , OR MIDRIFF-BARING SHIRTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Teacher has the right to refuse permission for any apparel deemed inappropriate for the classroom.

Boy's Attire – black jazz pants or warm-up pants with a black or white T- shirt. Other colored Tees may be worn when it is not Visiting Day.

SHOES: Tap – black with elastic for ties, no jingle taps or toe taps with a lip of metal over the toe. Girls 13 and up may have black oxfords.

Ballet – pink with elastic across the instep.

Jazz – black jazz shoes

Hip Hop – black jazz shoes, black dance sneakers as a 2nd pair optional

Musical Theatre – black jazz shoes. Advanced students also need beige character shoes.

All shoes should be clearly marked with dancer's name. Any students who change shoes during or in between classes are requested to have a dance bag also marked with their name.

CLASSROOM INFORMATION:

*Hair needs to be secured out of the eyes.

*Cell phones need to be turned off during class.

*No chewing gum,

*No food or drinks in the classroom.

*No drinking water during class.

*Proper attire as listed above.

*CDs can be made (\$5.00 each song) for performances.

*No visitors except on Visiting Days. (Out of town Grand- parents an exception.)
